Subject: BOUNDARY INTERPRETATION No.: 02-21 for Tax Map Key: 3-1-42: 2, 3, 14 and various road easements, Diamond Head, Honolulu, Oahu, Hawaii

Pursuant to your correspondence dated June 10, 2002, and June 20, 2002, requesting a boundary interpretation for the road easements abutting the subject parcels, please be advised that we have determined that the road easements are located within the State Land Use (SLU) Conservation District.

Our determination is based on the Commission's records and official maps currently on file at our office. For your information, the location of the SLU Urban / Conservation District boundary for portions of the subject area was established pursuant to SLU Docket No. A67-152 Land Use Commission.

We have enclosed for your reference a copy of a previously prepared boundary interpretation dated July 28, 1977, on which we delineated an approximate location of the SLU Urban / Conservation District boundary relative to the subject area. Please note that on said interpretation, we have specifically highlighted only that portion of the district boundary relevant to the area in question. Since the interpretation, the district boundary on the northeast portion of Diamond Head was amended to include additional lands within the Conservation District pursuant to SLU Docket No. BR93-692 Office of State Planning.
